

# SENIOR MISSION TRIP GUIDELINES

Class of 2010

1. You are to consider Highland Academy staff in charge while on this trip. All requests for special considerations must be brought to them. Other adults traveling with us will make such decisions when it is absolutely necessary or in other emergencies.
2. Each student will be assigned to a Highland Academy staff member, and there will be certain times throughout the trip when you will be asked to check in with him or her.
3. Highland dress code standards are in effect at all times on this trip, particularly concerning shorts because of climbing up and down ladders at the job sites. (Church attire: Guys – dress pants, shirt and tie, Girls – dress or skirt and blouse)
4. Please KEEP ALL RISK-TYPE ACTIVITIES TO A MINIMUM since we won't have any emergency medical help readily available.
5. Swimming may only be done in an area that is supervised by Highland Staff.
6. ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, DRUGS, ETC., MAY BE READILY AVAILABLE. ABSTINENCE IS THE ONLY WAY TO GO.
7. All Highland rules are in effect on the trip. Please keep this in mind.
8. Remember that joking about carrying drugs, weapons, smuggling, hijacking, etc., may very likely land you in JAIL for an indefinite length of time.
9. Be where the activities are going on at all times. IF YOU WANT TO GO SOMEWHERE, YOU MUST CLEAR IT WITH A HIGHLAND ACADEMY STAFF MEMBER.
10. NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED IN THE SLEEPING QUARTERS OF THE OPPOSITE SEX FOR ANY REASON.
11. Do not become "special friends" with the local people. (No social relationships)
12. If you choose to break major rules, you will be sent home at your parents' expense.
